The Grand Equestrians Therapeutic Riding Program was founded 30 years ago under the direction of Michigan State University, who helped set standards for Instructor training and certification. The program continues as an MSU Extension Livingston County 4-H Program, made possible only by the dedication of it's volunteers.

Therapeutic Horseback Riding benefits the rider's Posture, Gait, Balance, Coordination, Strength, Flexibility, as well as promotes Self-Awareness, Self Confidence, Concentration and Self Discipline.

This program is one of the only Therapeutic Riding Programs in Michigan that is provided at no cost to the riders.
